Total meals distributed (half year to date) = 72,150; # of families enrolled to receive food assistance = 390: representing 1661 individuals

FISH Emergency Homeless Shelter:

Total # of bed nights = 7.816No. of adult bed nights = 5063No. of children = 1506No. of veterans = 1247This represents 59 unduplicated individuals – 42 adults, 7 children, and 10 veterans
